

Open Enrollment/Tuition

Dear Parent/Guardian:

In an attempt to meet the needs of parents and students, the Kenton County Board of Education does not restrict students to local neighborhood schools. Parents may, within the necessary limits (as listed below) and available space, select the school their child will attend.

If you are interested in your child attending a school outside your attendance area next year, please note the following guidelines and limitations:

- The OPEN ENROLLMENT/TUITION POLICY pertains only to those living with district boundaries of The Kenton County School District.
- OPEN ENROLLMENT/TUITION FOR KINDERGARTEN WILL TAKE PLACE DURING KINDERGARTEN REGISTRATION ON FEB. 13, 2014.
- Parents may apply for permission to transfer schools through this process between December 9, 2013 and January 16, 2014. The date of return may be a deciding factor in the approval process of each applicant. Decisions shall be made after February 3, 2014 and prior to Feb. 14, 2014.
- Parents are to provide all transportation.
- Students shall meet and maintain the following requirements:
 1. Satisfactory academic progress and academic effort as determined by the principal.
 2. District attendance policies including matching the district's average attendance and not exceeding six (6) unexcused absences.
 3. Behave in accordance with the Code of Expected Behavior and Conduct.
- The parents/guardians are cooperative and supportive in their working relationship with the school.
- Athletic eligibility is determined by KHSAA guidelines for grades 6-12.
- The transfer is subject to change, if enrollment exceeds capacity for a given school or if the Open Enrollment/Tuition contract is violated at any time.
