### **II. Opening Business:**

a. **Agenda Approval**: The agenda was approved; first motion by Amy Granger; second motion by TJ Cox. Consensus was reached.

- c. **Good News**: Dr. Castleman reported that the FunRun Boosterthon raised almost \$30,000 for technology for the school. R.C.
