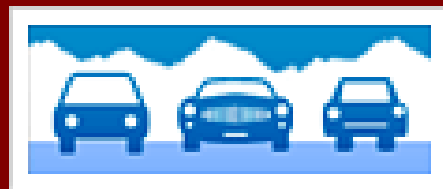

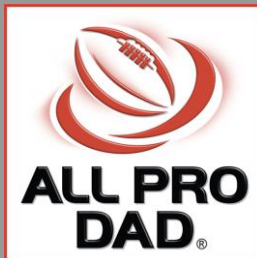
Transportation changes cannot be made over the phone.

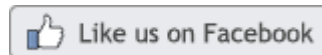
In each newsletter this year, P.B.I.S. updates will be shared. A revision to the P.B.I.S. program this school year is the newly adopted color chart. Students are now able to
