Road work may affect travel

Buttermilk Pike - Northern Kentucky Water District has crews working on replacing the water main along Buttermilk Pike from Rogers Road to Meadowood. This project is anticipated to be completed by the end of May 2018. Lane closures controlled by flaggers can be expected throughout the project.

CR 1316 (Bromley-Crescent Springs Road) - from Anderson to Amsterdam Road - Traffic will be impacted by geotechnical drilling crews and equipment performing preliminary investigations for roadway design on Bromley Crescent Springs Road. Lane closures controlled by flaggers can be expected starting February 12th, after 8:30 AM, Monday through Friday for approximately 3 weeks. Motorists should watch for crews, equipment, flaggers and expect short delays. Motorists should exercise caution when traveling in work zones.

We ask for your patience as road work may cause delays in bus pick up and drop off. Please use the Kenton County Bus Buddie to track your child's bus if it is running late. Thank you!

Right now, there is a close race between 3rd grade, 2nd grade and Kindergarten. We are close to reaching our goal of 96.78% attendance rate for the year! Keep up the great work with ensuring students are on time and at school each day!

We are in the time of year when viruses flourish in the community. We encourage everyone to help reduce the risk of infection by following these guidelines:

- Wash hands often with soap and water for 20 seconds, especially after changing diapers. If soap and water are not available use an alcohol based hand sanitizer.
- Avoid touching eyes, nose, and mouth with unwashed hands.
- Cover your mouth and nose with a tissue when you cough or sneeze and put your used tissue in the waste basket. If you don't have a tissue, cough or sneeze into your upper sleeve or elbow, not your hands.
- Avoid kissing, hugging, and sharing cups or eating utensils with people who are sick.
- Stay home when feeling sick, and consult their health care provider as needed. Children with cold like symptoms that experience difficulty breathing should consult their health care provider for further evaluation.
- Disinfect frequently touched surfaces, such as handrails and doorknobs, especially if someone is sick.
- **In addition, we encourage vaccination against influenza, it isn't too late**

There are new immunization guidelines for the 2018-19 school year. All K-12 students must show proof of receiving two doses of Hepatitis A vaccine and students 16 years or older need proof of receiving two doses of Meningococcal ACWY vaccine to attend school. The KCS D is asking all parents/guardians to contact their child's health care provider to ensure these guidelines have been met. If your child receives vaccines, please provide the school with a new immunization certificate.

2018 Villa Hills Longhorns Instructional Baseball League: Sign-Up Information

For the 2018 baseball season, the Villa Hills Longhorns Athletic Association will again be offering youth "instructional" baseball. Because of the success in previous years, we will again be offering both a "tee ball" level as well as a "coach pitch."

These leagues are created & supported to make baseball a fun, learning experience for all kids. All practices & games are local (Villa Madonna & Franze Fields in Villa Hills), and all games are played on Saturday mornings/early afternoons.

Tee-Ball League (ages 4-5)

The Villa Hills Longhorns will again offer a local league for our youngest kids, meant to introduce them to baseball. This is an "entry level" league for those playing baseball for the first time - with the purpose of using tees to allow for more "in game action" of the ball being put in play, as well as eliminating the fear-factor of playing with a hard ball. Practices will be 1x per week, and all games will be played on Saturdays at Franzen Fields in Villa Hills.

Tee-Ball Details:

- Organized teams made up of local Villa Hills & Crescent Springs kids (other surrounding cities are welcome assuming we can accommodate the # of kids)
- Targeted to ages 4-5,
- Season will run from ~April 1st thru June 24th
- Games are ~3 innings long, with a tee being used to allow for a safer, more exciting experience
- Coaches: *Over the past 3-4 years, we have been consistently low on coaches. Please consider signing up to help...no baseball experience is required* - and ultimately we want coaches that will make the experience fun for the players. Practice plans/tips will be offered to those coaches looking for help

Coach Pitch Details:


- Organized teams made up of local Villa Hills & Crescent Springs kids (other surrounding cities are welcome assuming we accommodate the # of kids)
