| <p><b><u>Proficiency</u></b></p> <p>By 2023, River Ridge Elementary will increase the combined reading and math percentage of students scoring proficient/distinguished from 65% in 2018 to 82% as measured by the school report card.</p>  | <p><b>Reading</b> - Increase our percentage of student scoring proficient/distinguished in reading from 66% to 69.4% in 2019 as measured by the school report card.</p> <p><b>Math</b> - increase our percentage of students scoring proficient/distinguished in math from 64% to 67.6% in 2019 as measured by the school report card.</p>  |
