Attendance: Jerry Cline, Laura Fuller, Amy Eads, Allison Stacy-Schaefer, Erin Jordan, Toni Walden, Terrah Kelly, Dave Campbell and Corinne Renner

Approval of Agenda and Minutes: Ms. Walden motioned and Ms. Jordan seconded, approved by consensus.

Good News: Mr. Cline informed the committee of a new feature in the newsletter where parents can write a positive note about a teacher. He shared two of the notes he received. He also informed the committee that the chorus had received a distinguished rating for their recent performance. The Archery team is going to the Nationals in Louisville.

Old Business

Budget Report: Mr. Cline discussed the budget report with the committee and stated that we have the option to carry over 10%. The SBDM committee was in agreement with the carry over.

Springboard: Mr. Cline stated that we are fortunate that Springboard will be funded next year by the district as a non-consumable. It was discussed that Mr. Cline and teachers are working on an implementation plan for the Springboard resource for next school year.

New Business

Staffing Allocation Plan: Mr. Cline presented the staffing allocation plan to the committee. He proposed that SBDM fund a math position. It was discussed that the grant money from Safe Schools will go towards a Behavior Interventionist teacher, Instructional Assistant and a portion (.2) of a counselor. Mr. Cline described the duties of the Interventionist position including regular proactive behavior interventions including individual and group meetings. SBDM committee was in agreement. Ms. Stacy-Schaefer motioned to approve the Safe School grant proposal as well as SBDM funding the Math teacher, Ms. Eads seconded, approved by consensus.

Ms. Fuller asked about some specific scheduling details and Mr. Cline suggested that a Scheduling Committee be formed to finalize the schedule. The SBDM committee was in agreement. A scheduling committee will be formed.

2018-2019 PD Plan: Mr. Cline presented the proposed PD plan to the committee. Ms. Stacy-Schaefer noticed a conflict and stated she would reach out to the district consultant. Ms. Stacy-Schaefer motioned, Ms. Eads seconded, approved by consensus.

PBIS Behavior Review: Mr. Campbell discussed recent behavior data with the committee. There has been a better presence of staff in the hallway during class change and it is making a big difference.

Allison Stacy-Schaefer made a motion to adjourn the meeting. Laura Fuller seconded the motion. Consensus was reached by the council. The meeting adjourned at 4:45.
