Teachers are looking at formative assessment data as well as MAP results. Mr. Schwartz shared an idea for a common assessment using a “bell ringer”. This was an idea that encore teachers could implement to support our overall Reading and Math focus here at Woodland.

School Improvement Planning: Mr. Cline reviewed the CSIP goals and spoke of the importance of our Reading and Math interventions for students who are getting extra support on top of their core instruction.
