**Policy Title:** Discipline and Classroom Management

**Policy Statement:**

Each student and guardian shall read the contents of the Kenton County School District's Code of Conduct Booklet.

The school shall develop a school safety plan as required by district policy and state regulations. The school safety plan shall be reviewed annually by the school council.

**Evaluation:**

School behavior data shall be analyzed quarterly by the PBIS committee. Trends shall be examined to determine causes and contributing factors.

**Policy Title:** Attendance

**Policy Statement:**

Any student with 10 or more unexcused absences shall not walk in the graduation procession or participate in graduation activities. (Ex. Senior lap, senior picnic, brunch, etc..) Principal has authority to override for extenuating circumstances. (Ex. Extended illness, late unexcused events, etc...)

Attendance policy for excusing absences will follow the District Code of Conduct for excusing absences.
