1. Opening Business

2. Student Achievement Data - In 2021 Spring MAP, 75.6% (Reading) and 70.3% (Math) of our Hinsdale Elementary students are above benchmark (50th percentile). Dr. Castleman gave many praises for teachers, parents and students throughout the pandemic to make Hinsdale Elementary successful in our Spring MAP Test. We are #1 in the district in Spring MAP Data (both Reading and Math), as well as student participation (4th and 5th grades).

3. Budget Report – The council reviewed the current budget. Mrs. Harmon gave the first motion to approve the budget and Mr. Cabrera gave the second. Consensus was reached.

4. Ad Hoc Committee Report

- a. ELA – The ELA Ad Hoc met and reviewed samples. The grade-level teams have met and we plan on discussing more at our April staff meeting next week. We want to make sure we are confident in our decision to select a new ELA curriculum.
- b. Summer Learning – Mr. Chevalier presented our Hinsdale plan for summer learning. In June, all Hinsdale students will have an opportunity to participate in

our enrichment portion of the summer program. In July, students that are receiving interventions will be invited into the building for in-person instruction related to Reading and Math. The student/teacher ratio will be close to 15-1 to benefit that need additional summer learning support.
