Arrival and Dismissal

We know that everyone is excited for the start of school. We ask that all families continue to stay consistent with the arrival and dismissal procedures. The first few days and/or weeks can be very challenging to get students where they need to be.

- A.M. Dropoff Time: 8:00 AM - 8:50 AM by the Gymnasium.
 - Tardy Bell will ring at 8:50. **If your student is not in the gym by 8:50 AM you will need to drive your student to the bus loop for a tardy note.**
- P.M. Pickup Time: 3:30 PM by the Gymnasium
 - Students will be called down to the gym at 3:25. **Please do not get to school before 3:00 PM.** We will still have students on the playground. Our SRO, Officer Twehues, will have the gate blocking anyone from entering the playground early.

Please read the quick tips to help us have a successful transition into the 21-22 school year.

- If your child or children are bus riders, please send them on the bus to start the school year. Consistency is the key for a great start to the school year.
- Parents/Guardians should follow the car rider map below for instructions on how to drop your child or children off.
- Parents/Guardians should not be parking and walking their child or children to school.** This is an adjustment, at first, but it works best for all our students and staff.

Hinsdale, we use the Car Rider Pro System to assist with getting all students to where they need.
