Falcon Families,

This week the KCS D has resumed COVID random sample testing for students in grades 2-12. (If you do not wish for your child to participate in the COVID testing and have already opted your child out, there is nothing further you need to do at this time.) The testing will be administered every other week. The results from each school will determine which level that school will follow for the following two weeks. There are some changes to note with our dashboard levels and they are shown in the COVID Dashboard Action Plan chart below. The KCS D has made these changes to increase the number of students attending in-person safely through monitoring results from sample testing.

<u>Expanded Hybrid Model</u> 3.1-8% All Students who chose in-person learning in "hybrid" school A/B rotational model (School level criteria maximizing daily capacity socially distancing at all times)	All in-person P-5, 5 days per week social distancing six feet.
<u>Normal as Possible</u> 0-3% All Students who chose in-person learning in school 5 days a week (Socially Distanced or as close to 6 feet as possible)	All in-person P-5, 5 days per week social distancing six feet.

Testing results and levels will be shared on Friday for the following two weeks. Thank you for your continued understanding and we are so excited to hopefully see all our in-person Falcons return to school next week.
