 - No outdoor activities may take place during lightning or other severe inclement weather
 - Practices and games must be postponed if Central Office cancels all evening/weekend events district wide
 - Requirements on the heat index, humidity, etc. from KHSAA must be followed
 - Coaches must attend all KHSAA rule clinics
 - Coaches must be CPR Certified (trained by designated providers)
 - One person certified in medical training protocol from KHSAA must be present at all times during practices or events
- The coach must be trained by the school nurse in administration of medications for students needing them
- Practice and game schedules must adhere to board policy on Sundays and Holidays
- Assistant coaches and volunteers working with this program must be trained on all items above. Trainings may be by the head coach, through KHSAA trainings, and from designated providers.
